



An opportunity to become part of Bath's History

The Bath Masonic Hall Trust has recently opened its doors four days a week for guided tours to the public. The building, which dates from 1750, was originally the first Provincial Theatre Royal, and then in 1809 became a Catholic Chapel before being acquired in 1865 by Royal Sussex Lodge No.53. The tour covers the history of all three usages, as well as access to the Masonic Museum in the vaults of the building: for more details visit www.oldtheatroyal.com
